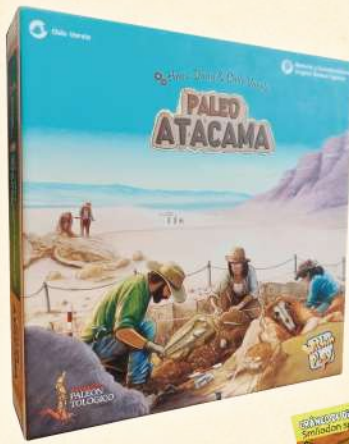




PALEO ATACAMA



The Atacama Desert, one of the oldest and driest places on Earth, hides beneath its surface a treasure of fossils that reveal the history of life on our planet. In this extreme landscape, players lead scientific expeditions to unearth discoveries and build a prestigious museum.

Main Mechanics

Exploration and Excavation (set collection):

Players use Excavation Permits to intervene in zones of the desert, carefully choosing terrain types (sand, gravel, or rock) that determine the amount and type of fossils they can uncover. A marker placed at an excavation site associates that dig with a specific era: Paleozoic, Mesozoic, or Cenozoic.

Museum Assembly (puzzle):

The fossils collected are transferred to display cases within your Museum Board.

By organizing discoveries according to organism classification and geological era, players complete thematic exhibition halls that grant increasing Prestige Points.



Museography and Prestige:

Each exhibition hall can be enhanced with Infographics, Panels, or Replicas, increasing the Prestige generated by the museum and awarding additional Victory Points at the end of the game.

Prestige act as the game's currency, used to dig, acquire equipment, or implement museography.

Professionals:

Depending on the types of discoveries your museum exhibits, at the end of the game different specialists will be attracted to your museum, granting additional Victory Points.



Objective of the Game

Manage your own paleontological museum and make it the most prestigious in Chile. Plan excavations, request permits, organize your findings, and build unique exhibitions to gain scientific and cultural recognition. Win by achieving the highest number of Victory Points at the end of the game.

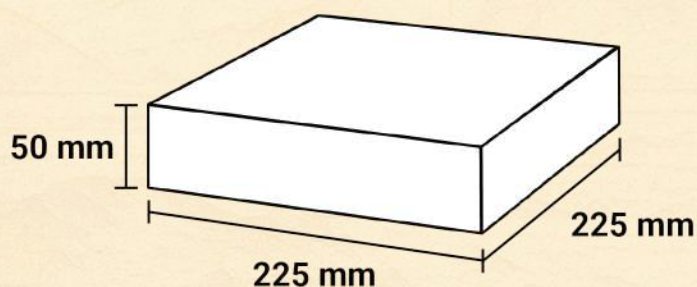
