## **ILAN**









Antarctica is a singular and fascinating continent: Despite its hostility, it harbors a surprising network of biodiversity—from tiny microalgae to colossal whales. Inspired by the Yaghan word ilan, meaning "south wind," this game takes that idea as a symbol of exploration and movement, inviting players to learn about, value, and protect the Antarctic natural heritage through awe and scientific curiosity.

#### **Core Mechanic**

• Set Collection: Players collect Biodiversity cards that represent different Antarctic species, classified by different colors (different trophic levels). These cards have active, passive, and conditional abilities that simulate the dynamism of ecological processes in Antarctica. The abilities on these cards grant in-game benefits and Victory Points. Furthermore, these cards can be used to form Trophic Webs—sequences of or different colors—which grant many Victory Points.











#### **Biodiversity Cards:**

Green: producers
Blue: invertebrates

Yellow: fish

Orange: birds and seals Red: large mammals


 Factor Cards represent external influences, both natural and human. They feature special abilities that grant different benefits. Their true potential emerges when combined with the Biodiversity Cards, as together they allow for powerful combos.




